Asthma requiring medication:

Initial report to the FAA

Please provide a current status letter from the treating physician to include:

A spirometer report and a current status letter that reviews the severity of Asthma including any hospital admissions.

Also, a statement regarding medication and dosage, as well as presence of side effects of medications.

Recertification:

Provide a current status letter from the treating physician stating the control of the asthma, symptoms, and any hospitalizations. A spirometry is not required, but if performed a copy should be provided and commented on by the physician in the letter.

List all medication, including dose and frequency used and any side effects and if oral steroid was used, what dose and for how long.

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
