HYPERTENSION

Initial report to the FAA

1. Please provide a current status letter from the treating physician to include: an assessment of risk factors for coronary heart disease, a clinical examination that includes 3 recent BP readings, a summary of BP readings, a summary of BP medications used with dosages, a statement regarding any side effects, or end organ damage (such as renal, ophthalmological or cerebrovascular).
2. An EKG done and interpreted within the last 3 months.
3. Lab reports within the last 90 days of blood sugar, lipid profile, potassium and creatinine levels.

If hypertension was previously reported on a prior exam

1. Please provide a current status letter from the treating physician dated within the last 90 days to include 3 BP readings, a list of the medications with dosages, any side effects from the medication and any evidence of end organ damage.
2. If a diuretic is used a current, within the last 90days, Potassium.

The information can be faxed this to the office before your exam for review so I can notification you of any deficiencies before your appointment. Make sure to include a cover letter with a contact phone number and short note as to why you faxed the information.
