

# Glaucoma

Pilots who are using any medications to lower intraocular (eye) pressure for Open Angle Glaucoma or Ocular Hypertension are disqualified and require a F.A.A. review and Special Issuance.

## **Pilots must provide:**

F.A.A. Form 8500-14-Glaucoma Eye Evaluation form completed by the treating eye specialist; and  
a set of Visual Field Measurements.

If vision meets standards, there are no significant visual field defects and no side effects of the medication a 6 years Special Issuance of a Medical Certification (Authorization) will be issued. The medical certificate will be time limited to “not valid for any class after 12 months following the month of issuance”.

## **On subsequent certification:**

An updated current Form 8500-14 must be completed by the treating eye specialist and visual field measurements preformed.

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
